Pelican Cancer Foundation

The Pelican Cancer Foundation, established just six years ago, was created to further the pioneering surgical work pursued by Professor Bill Heald and other colleagues in Basingstoke. Their main focus of activity has been to improve delivery of precision surgery for bowel, liver and prostate cancer over the last 25 years.

Pelican is derived from **Pelvic** and **Liver Cancer**, with a clear focus on **precision surgery treatment, clear and accurate imaging** and **research and education**.

Since its creation, immense strides have been made in bowel and liver cancer surgery, particularly through the deployment of a technique for bowel cancer surgery, developed by Professor Heald, that has become the 'gold' standard for bowel cancer surgery worldwide.

Over the last three years, Pelican has now delivered a highly successful National Development Programme for all bowel cancer clinical teams across the country. Every hospital Trust offering bowel cancer treatment has participated, nearly 200 of them, seeking to improve treatment and clinical outcomes throughout England – a unique partnership between a cancer charity and the Department of Health.

Bowel and liver cancer work continues whilst similar advances in the treatment of **prostate cancer** are now the principal target, particularly by enhanced imaging and exciting new minimally invasive technology.
